

Self-Escorting of Abnormal Loads and Abnormal Vehicles Code of Practice - Compliance Certification



When notifying the movement of an abnormal load or abnormal load vehicle to the police, they may ask for a self-certificate or other evidence to show that the vehicles and personnel to be used comply with the Highways Agency Code of Practice (Self-Escorting of Abnormal Loads and Abnormal Vehicles).

We therefore recommend clients using Road Pilots either retain or attach a copy of this Compliance Statement together with corresponding movement notification documents.


